This youth exchange, gathering in Muckenbach (Alsace France) for 11 days 30 participants from 4 countries (SLOVENIA, SPAIN, GERMANY, FRANCE), mainly PWFO (among which refugees & migrants), intends to be a space of reflection about gender discrimination. From traditional culture to nowadays situations in various countries, communities, participants will, through non-formal tools, gain a better understanding of negative perceptions & how machismo and discriminations on gender can express in various cultures.

This youth exchange will gather youngsters among whom many with fewer opportunities, which will be named PWFO (people with fewer opportunities).

In each group, there will be sufficient number of leaders (3 French, 2 Spanish, 1 Sloven). Spanish & French groups are the ones with the youngest participants. In Sloven group an adult participant will help leader to cope with the group. Leaders & NGOs will choose freely their participants.

No selection will be made apart from age group, having some artistic interest (but no selection will be made on diploma or musical level). Special focus will be made on choosing participants PWFO.

Each group will organise their travel to Strasbourg by train, plane, bus or van. We'll take train/bus tickets from Strasbourg to Urmatt. We'll send to partners half of the cost of way & return travel to Strasbourg before exchange & complement will be given after they have sent all proofs (the total expenses cannot be over 275€/p for Slovenian & Spanish groups). Several times per day buses and trains connect Strasbourg to Urmatt which is only 6 km from accommodation place in Muckenbach near Grendelbruch. Groups will be driven on arrival at Urmatt by vans of Association Ballade. French group will come also to Urmatt & be fetched by our 2 vans, available in case of emergency.

Accommodation will be in Muckenbach, in mountain-refuge of Amis de la Nature (<http://www.muckenbach.org/>), in wild nature above touristic village of Grendelbruch. This big chalet was built in 1932 with 54 beds, a big modern kitchen, 2 big meeting rooms, modern sanitary. This place is fully agreed to host underage (Agrément Jeunesse et Sports N°67 S 872) & ruled by Amis de la Nature socio-cultural organisation for popular international education. Groundfloor is equipped for handicapped. Our group have exclusive use of the whole Centre with 2 big meeting rooms. Participants will be in rooms of 6 to 10 beds (there will be separated rooms for boys & girls) & leaders in 2 bed rooms. Participants will be in rooms with maximum 3 of same country/room. We will try to make the groups according to age so that the younger ones can be together. Association Ballade will provide sleeping bags.

A cook will be employed to make shopping & cooking for the group, & cleaning of showers, toilets. Participants will be in charge of keeping tidy & cleaning their rooms, helping with setting, un-setting & cleaning tables & meeting-rooms after meals & meetings.

They will agree to work on that theme, involve in preparatory activities & share info on a group social network or cloud space. They will have to agree to rules of life decreed for that exchange.

Speaking English or organizing inside group to have a "translator" is important to involve & understand theme & on theme activities. Participation to activities during year & good-spirited sense will be major required quality.

No activity will need special background or needs.
