AIM:

The main aim of the contact making seminar is to develop national and regional cooperation among the youth workers to share experiences and knowledge on working with NEET youth.

METHODOLOGY:

The program of the project will be based on non-formal education methodology and will be implemented by 2 facilitators.

## WHAT IS IT ABOUT:

Young people are a fundamental asset of our societies. There are over 94 million young people between 15 and 29 in Europe, which is an incredible resource for society. But to fully exploit their potential, they need to be integrated into society. For different reasons, not all young people can be involved in the labor market. There is a category of youth that is neither in employment nor in education and training ("NEETs").

With this CMS we want to establish national and regional cooperation of organizations directly working with youth to reduce the number of NEET young people and to open for them the world of youth opportunities, including Erasmus + Program.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

The project will bring together 27 youth workers from Czech Republic, Poland, Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Germany, Italy and Romania.

## PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS:

- Youth workers and youth leaders who are involved into the daily activities of the youth organizations
- age limit 18+
- be able to communicate in English
- gender balance (50/50)

## FINANCIAL CONDITIONS:

Accommodation and food: 100% covered by Erasmus+ Programme

Travel costs: are budgeted according Erasmus+ conditions (using the EU distance calculator)

Maximum reimbursement could be as following:

Poland - 180 EUR

Romania - 275 EUR

Croatia - 180 EUR

Hungary - 180 EUR

Germany - 180 EUR

Italy - 275 EUR

Slovenia - 180 EUR

Travel reimbursement will be done after the project on bank account upon receiving all tickets, invoices and boarding passes.

Only participants who attended all sessions are entitled to receive reimbursement.

## FACILITATORS:

**Alina Prochasek** - youth trainer with degree in law. Alina conducts workshops for different youth groups on local, national and international levels and she is involved in the SAD networking project (inter-regional cooperation of Youth Councils in Poland and Czech Republic). Mainly her work is focused on activating young people and raising a dialogue between them and other stakeholders. She underwent a series of international trainings on gamification and experiential learning.

**Nika Bunziak** - youth worker and trainer with considerable experience in non-formal education and volunteering. ## TRAVEL RULES

1. You can travel by 2nd or economy class only (no 1st class or business).
2. You should travel from your country to Czech Republic within 24 hours. Stopovers in another country over the night are not allowed.
3. If you want to have extra days in CZ, you can stay max 3 days before and/or after the project (only in CZ).
4. If you travel with no low-cost airlines, always consider return ticket (not one-way).
5. You can add extra luggage if its not included in the ticket.
6. Before you buy the ticket, please send us the itinerary of your journey for approval to avoid any misunderstanding.

The nearest and the most convenient airports around are: Prague, Bratislava, Vienna, Katowice/Krakow or Brno.

From these cities you can easily come by train to Uherské Hradiště or Kunovice ( These 2 cities are connected).

Kunovice train station is only 600m from the hotel, so we recommend it as the best point of arrival.

If you come by bus to Uherské Hradiště, you will need to later take public bus from there (n.2 to Sady, Rozcestník or n.5 to Sady, Špitálky).
