## Travel Information

Participants are requested to take the “Green Travel” - the travel that uses low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling. Please consider the principle of economy. All participants must get confirmation on the travel itinerary by the organizers before buying the tickets. All local transport will be arranged by the hosting organisation.

Travel costs are covered up-to the sums indicated in the table below, as per the Erasmus+ rules. For the reimbursement you have to provide invoices, tickets and boarding passes.
