In 2023, the Association EPEKA, a social enterprise, will continue its cooperation within the **Shoah – Remember 2023** project. In this year's edition of the project, we will conduct trainings for members of civil society, Roma activists and other participants who are interested in the prevention of discrimination against the Roma community.

The training will focus mainly on the topic of discrimination, on the identification of different types of discrimination, on the available legal remedies for victims of discrimination, on the competences of the bodies responsible for preventing and dealing with discrimination, and on the support mechanisms available to the Roma community when reporting discrimination. Participants will receive teaching materials related to the topics covered. Training is a as part of the project PRESS.
