Toolbox for Youth Workers: Training materials and workshops on closing skill gaps.

Policy Recommendations: Developed based on pilot projects and workshops, addressing youth employment challenges.

What are our objectives?

- ✔ Overcome skills mismatches by addressing labor market needs.

Youth Skills Academy: E-learning portal and Transnational Bootcamp for 30 participants focusing on 10 key job skills.

Local Training Series: 3-5 day workshops teaching job skills to 20 young people in each partner region.
