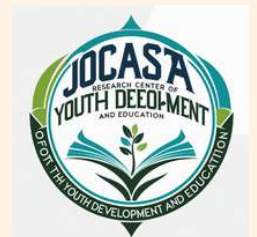

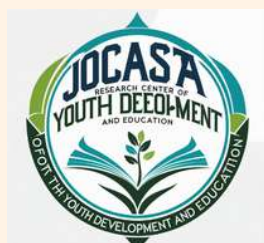


WHO ARE WE?

PROJECT'S AIMS

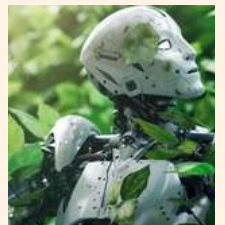
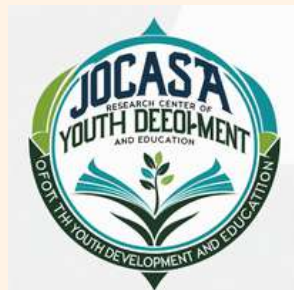

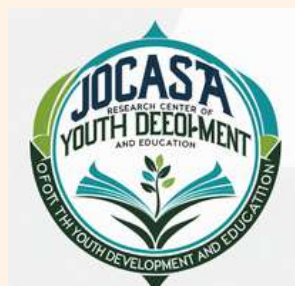
ACTIVITIES

The program blends concise theory, hands-on labs, and collaboration to prepare youth workers to lead robotics, AI, and eco-financing in sustainable community projects. It builds practical skills for waste, climate adaptation, and renewables; deepens crowdfunding/green-bond/ESG know-how; and strengthens mentoring and partner collaboration to turn knowledge into scalable, actionable environmental solutions.

Cultural evenings and integration activities provide a space for participants to connect, share experiences, and celebrate diversity, strengthening the bonds within the group. By the end of the program, participants will have co-created valuable resources and gained actionable insights to apply in their work with youth. The experience concludes with a celebration of achievements and personal reflections on the journey.

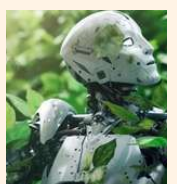


PREPARATION OF THE Youth Workers

- It is mandatory to have a passport/ID before travelling in order to be able to cross the border.
- if you take photos and there is a possibility to bring a camera, it will be very nice!
- preparation of a multicultural evening: presentation about your country, national music, food, snacks, drinks, dancing, games, quizzes.
- prepare at least 3 short energizers/games; each national team will be asked to lead energizers during the project.
- if you can, bring a laptop. it may be helpful with some workshops.
- stay updated on the WhatsApp group - if there is a need to prepare something else for the project we will inform you

RESPONSIBILITIES DURING AND AFTER THE PROJECT

Every national team must prepare a presentation and snacks for the cultural night, presentation+activity about work-life balance and work market for youth in their own country and some energizers.

All participants are expected to **participate fully** in all activities unless they are ill. In special instances (work,, private matters) you can of course talk to the coordinator about your schedule.

Unexcused absences from workshops are not permitted.

Workshops are organized and conducted in such a way that all participants can share their point of view. We expect you to be very active and involved.

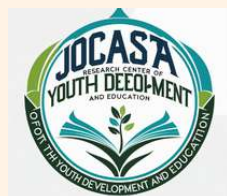


REIMBURSEMENT

- The project is **co-financed by the Erasmus+ programme**. The costs related to accommodation and food along with the coffee breaks will be covered by the coordinator organisation and the **travel costs will be reimbursed according to the Erasmus+ distance travel limits**. We will not be responsible for any loss of luggage, currency or personal effects, or any medical costs.
- Make sure that you keep all your **original travel tickets** (no screenshots) because they are needed for the reimbursement. Use only **PUBLIC TRANSPORT** and select the cheapest and/or affordable tickets. **Before booking any tickets, please contact the project coordinators**. Taxi is not eligible for the reimbursement.
- **Original tickets** must be sent, but participants need to ensure a copy or a photo of them as proof, in case of loss. Reimbursement will be done by the team leaders or the responsible people of each organisation. **This will happen after everyone finishes the dissemination and follow-up local activities, send original tickets and submit evaluation, survey and visibility posts. Keep in mind that the refund process might take months to be done, so patience is advisable.**
- **Before you buy tickets please consult the choice with us! Do not buy tickets without our confirmation!**
- **More information about the travel reimbursement procedure and all necessary forms will be provided during the project.**



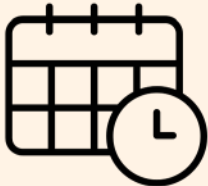

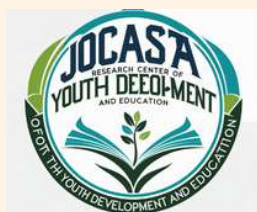

Cypriot TIPS

- Cyprus: Island country in the Eastern Mediterranean. Capital Nicosia. Languages Greek (English widely spoken. Currency Euro (€). Known for beaches, ancient sites, and warm, dry summers. Drives on the left.
- Electrical “switcher” (outlets): Cyprus uses Type G sockets (UK-style, often with switch on each outlet), 230 V, 50 Hz. Bring a Type G plug adapter; most devices with universal power supplies work fine—check your charger label for “100–240 V.”

Before coming to Cyprus, check the weather. One day we have sunny, the other day it can rain as it is a seaside. Take appropriate clothing.

There will be cultural evenings during the project.

Before arrival, prepare a quick presentation (20 min) about your country and a short quiz and maybe a dance. Take your flag and national symbols.

Don't forget about national food and snacks :)

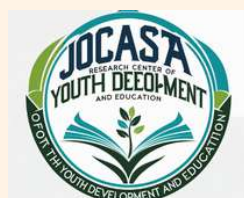
After Selecting participants you will be asked to add them in facebook and whatsapp group. They will be also asked to fill in the Google Drive form.

Each project participant should have a laptop with him/her in order to fully participate in activities during the project. As a last resort, at least one laptop per country.

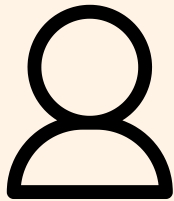
